## Value-for-money MBA from Strathclyde

THE master's of business administration (MBA) course at the University of Strathclyde is a value-for-money programme.

The findings appeared in the *Financial Times* MBA 2008 rankings, published on Jan 28. This survey assesses courses at universities around

Value for money was calculated on the basis of salaries which alumni currently earn, course length, fees and the opportunity cost of taking time out to study an MBA.

Strathclyde principal Professor Andrew Hamnett says: "These rankings reflect an excellent performance by everyone connected with the university's MBA course and they can all be justly proud of their achievements.

"The survey confirms that Strathclyde is one of the leading business schools in the UK and Europe, as well as significantly being one of only 27 worldwide to have accreditation from three of the world's main business
