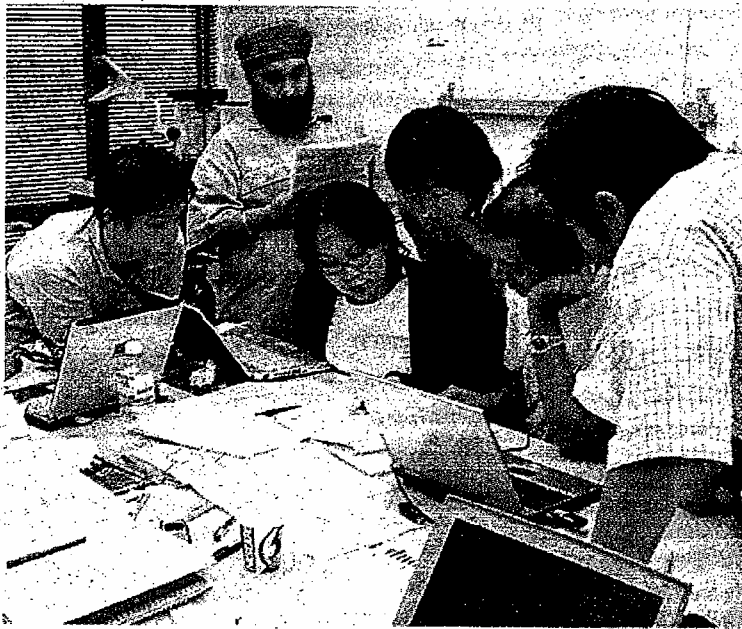


TOP MBA FROM BRITAIN
